A CHURCH-BASED APPROACH
TO ENDING FAMILY HOMELESSNESS



OUR GOAL

is a \$1,000,000 endowment over the next decade. We are about one-third of the way there. Your transformational gift, through outright, estate or planned giving, can help make it possible.

THE BRIDGE FOR TOMORROW ENDOWMENT will provide steps toward organizational sustainability by generating necessary annual funds from the interest, as well as providing a safety net during times of ministry growth. All earnings will be unrestricted and utilized to ground Bridge of Hope National for release of mission and ministry with more homeless women, children, and churches across the United States.

THIS ENDOWMENT FUND was established in 2008 with specific guidelines and restrictions. On a very limited and specific basis, this permanently restricted fund will allow for loans on principal for program expansion and growth, upon approval by the Board of Directors. Loan specifications include repayment of principal and interest at prime during specific times of program expansion. This fund is invested in a conservative manner with a reputable investment firm to provide a prudent rate of return.





Aquila's bequest for the Bridge for Tomorrow Endowment Fund will help to end homelessness for single mothers and children across the country for years to come.
