
### **Who do you center in your daily activities?**

I recently read some thoughts by author Sarah Bessey and was captivated by her call to followers of Jesus to look to the margins of society and notice who is there. *"The margins are our center.... Centered on those on the margins, God is re-centering us,"* she writes.

At Bridge of Hope, we are striving to center families facing homelessness as we make decisions, plan strategies and seek to expand services to end homelessness for more moms and children. We are also focused on learning from women with lived experience of homelessness. Our national board and many of our local boards have program alumna actively engaged in setting

policy and making strategic decisions about the future of our work with families and Neighboring Volunteers from churches. And this perspective is making us stronger in our services to families who are in the midst of homelessness.
